## The Controversy

“His blood *be* on us and on our children.”

**Matthew 27:24-25**

Pilate...washed *his* hands before the multitude, saying,

"I am innocent of the blood of this just Person. You see *to it*."

<sup>25</sup> And all the people answered and said, "His blood *be* on us and on our children."

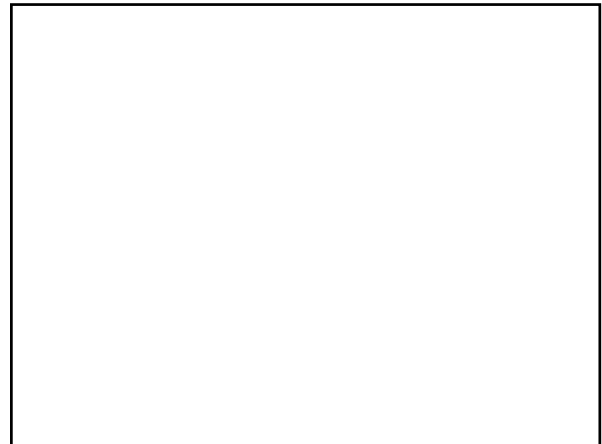

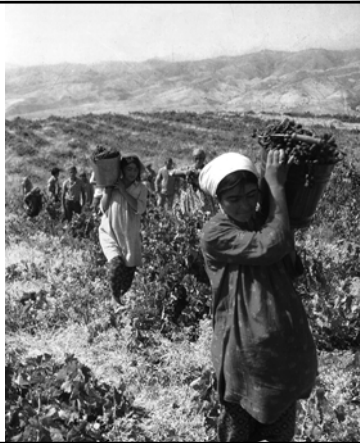

7 Matthew 21:33  
<sup>33</sup> “Hear another parable: There was a certain landowner who planted a vineyard and set a hedge around it, dug a winepress in it and built a tower. And he leased it to vinedressers and went into a far country. <sup>34</sup> Now when vintage-time drew near, he sent his servants to the vinedressers, that they might receive its fruit. <sup>35</sup> And the vinedressers took his servants, beat one, killed one, and stoned another.

Matthew 21:35  
<sup>35</sup> And the vinedressers took his servants, beat one, killed one, and stoned another. <sup>36</sup> Again he sent other servants, more than the first, and they did likewise to them. <sup>37</sup> Then last of all he sent his son to them, saying, ‘They will respect my son.’ <sup>38</sup> But when the vinedressers saw the son, they said among themselves, ‘This is the heir. Come, let us kill him and seize his inheritance.’ <sup>39</sup> So they took him and cast *him* out of the vineyard and killed *him*.

7 Matthew 21:40  
<sup>40</sup> “Therefore, when the owner of the vineyard comes, what will he do to those vinedressers?”  
<sup>41</sup> They said to Him, “He will destroy those wicked men miserably, and lease *his* vineyard to other vinedressers who will render to him the fruits in their seasons.”

## Parable of the workers in the Vineyard

- Landowner – God, the Father
- Vineyard - Israel
- Hedge – Walls of Jerusalem
- Winepress – Sacrificial Altar
- Tower – The Temple
- His servants - Prophets
- Vinedressers – Wicked Generation of Yeshua's Day
- Son – The Messiah

## John 15

"I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser.  
<sup>2</sup> Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit He takes  
away; and every *branch* that bears fruit He prunes, that  
it may bear more fruit. <sup>3</sup> You are already clean because  
of the word which I have spoken to you. <sup>4</sup> Abide in Me,  
and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself,  
unless it abides in the vine, neither can you, unless you  
abide in Me.

**John 15**

<sup>5</sup> "I am the vine, you *are* the branches. He who abides in Me, and I in him, bears much fruit; for without Me you can do nothing. <sup>6</sup> If anyone does not abide in Me, he is cast out as a branch and is withered; and they gather them and throw *them* into the fire, and they are burned.

<sup>7</sup> If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you. <sup>8</sup> By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit; so you will be My disciples.

**John 15**

<sup>9</sup> "As the Father loved Me, I also have loved you; abide in My love. <sup>10</sup> If you keep My commandments, you will abide in My love, just as I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love.

<sup>11</sup> "These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may remain in you, and *that* your joy may be full.

**Revelation 14:18**

<sup>18</sup> And another angel came out from the altar, who had power over fire, and he cried with a loud cry to him who had the sharp sickle, saying, "Thrust in your sharp sickle and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth, for her grapes are fully ripe." <sup>19</sup> So the angel thrust his sickle into the earth and gathered the vine of the earth, and threw *it* into the great winepress of the wrath of God. <sup>20</sup> And the winepress was trampled outside the city, and blood came out of the winepress, up to the horses' bridles, for one thousand six hundred furlongs.
