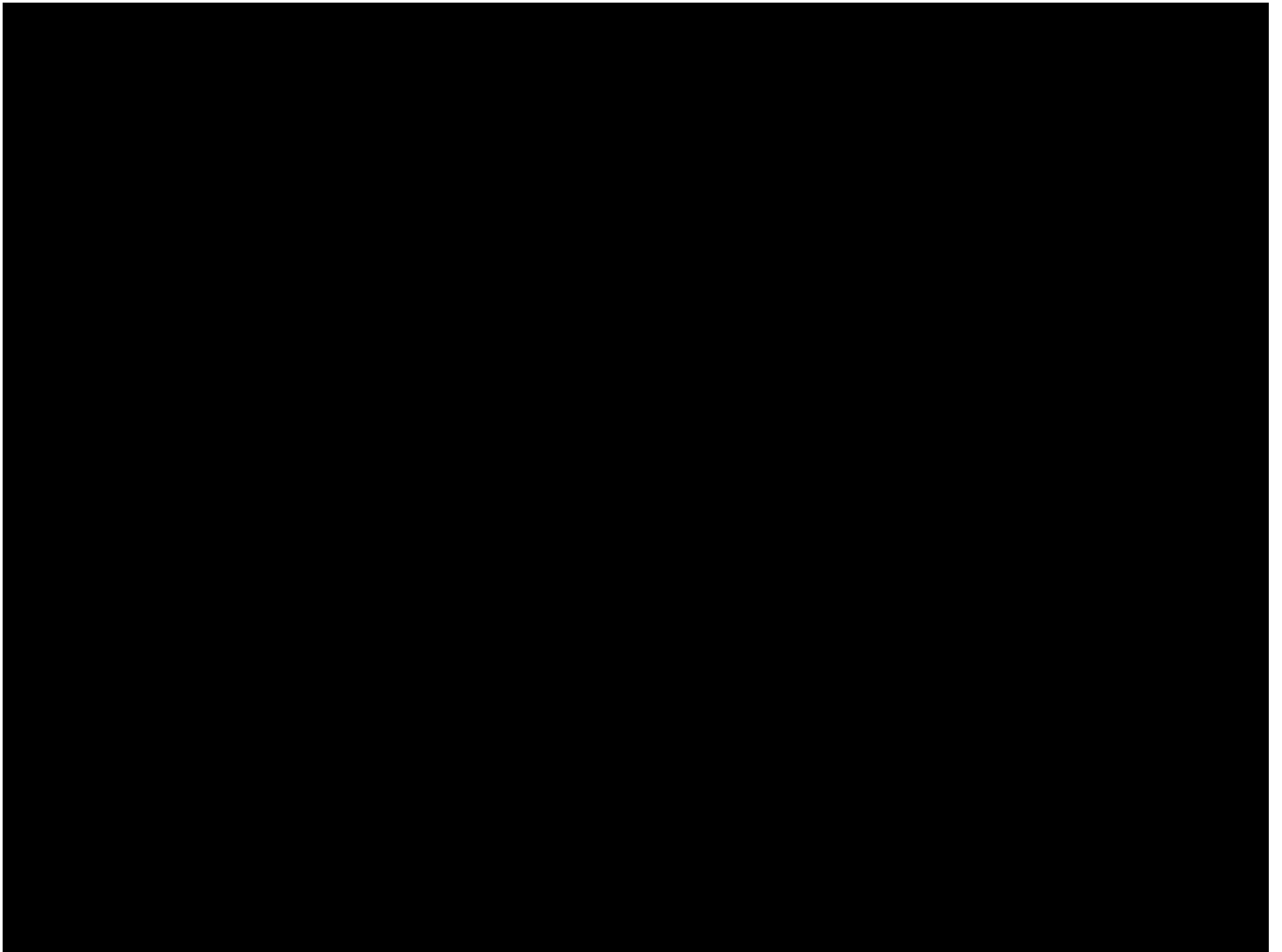

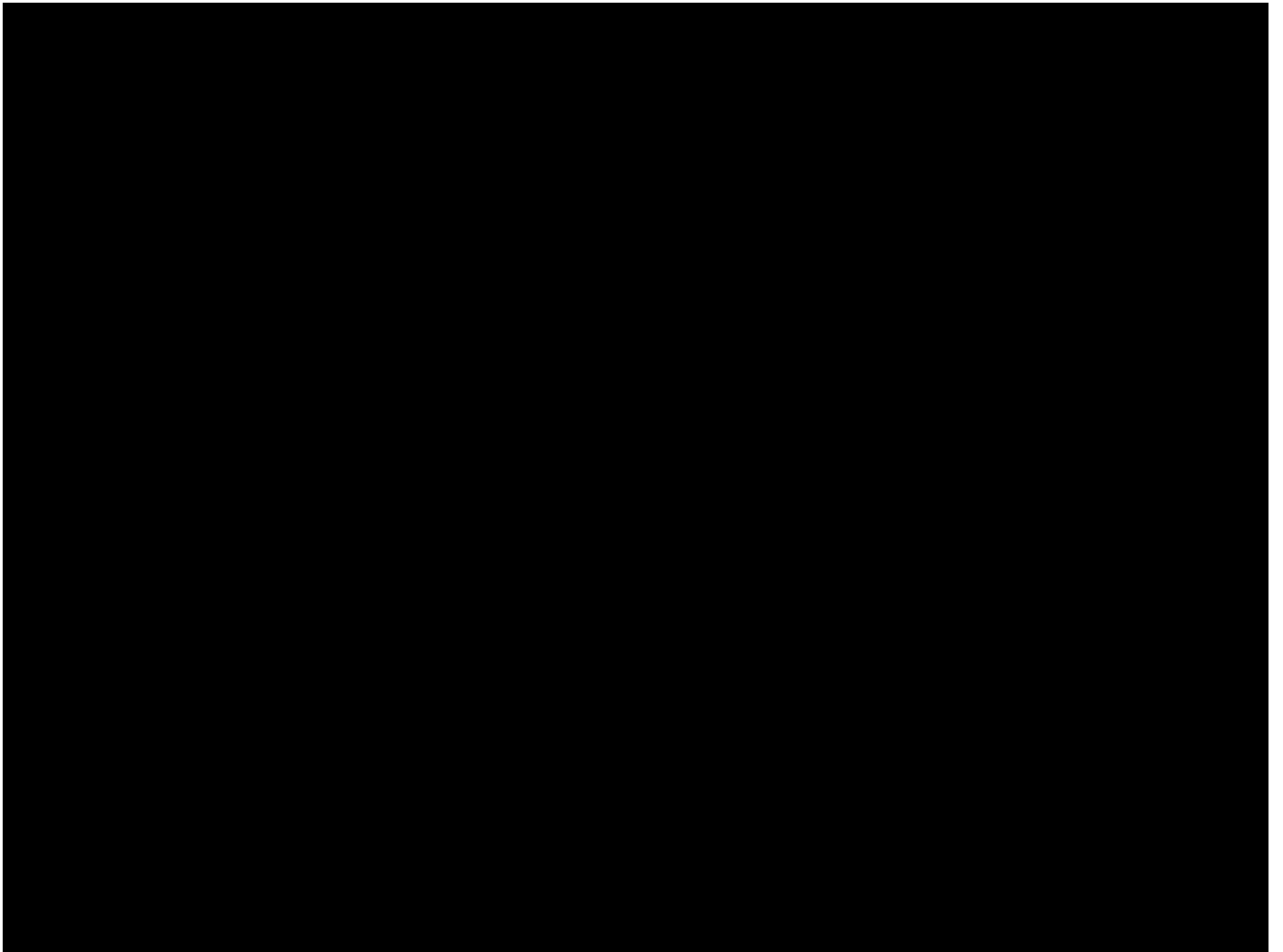

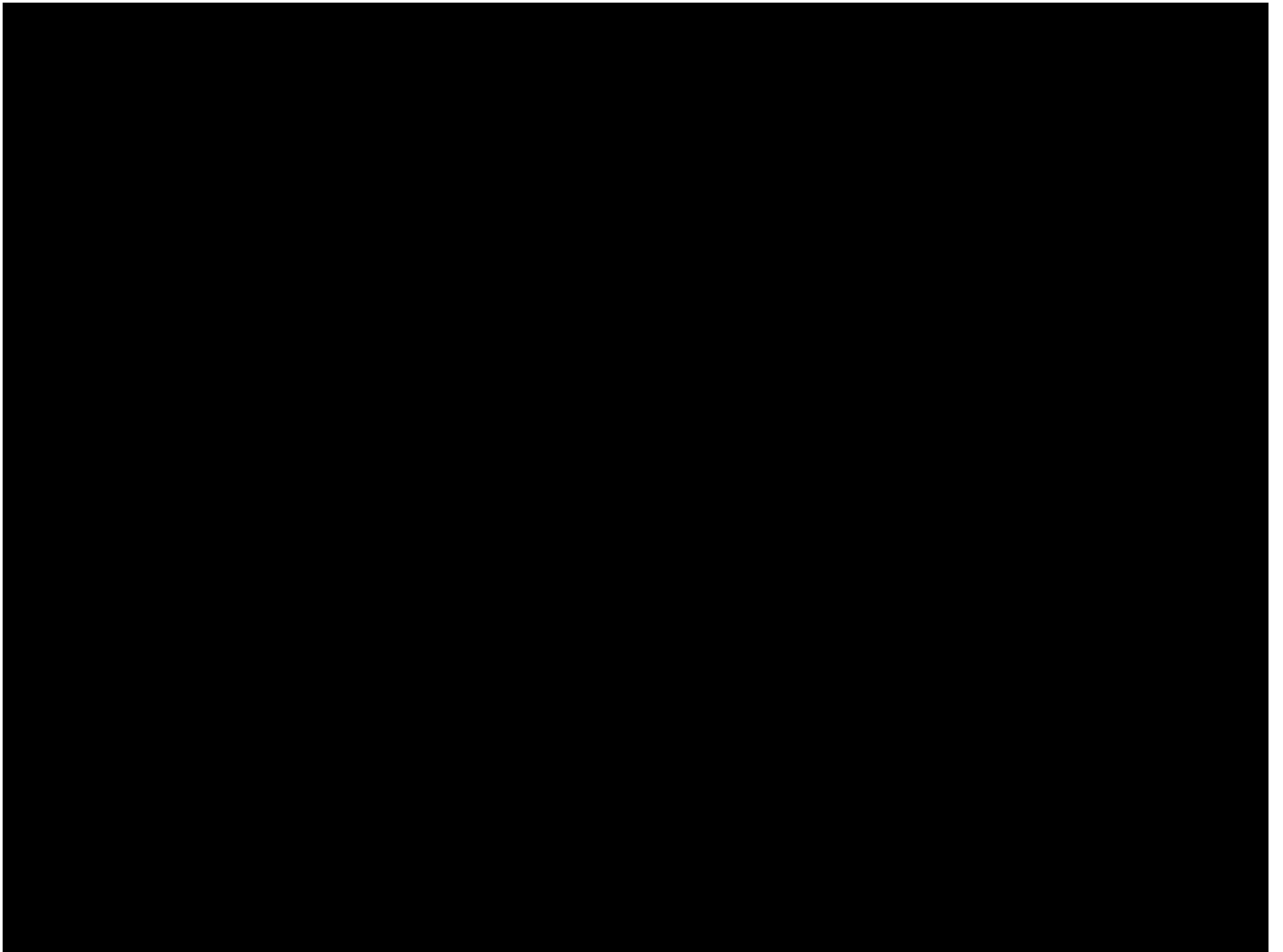

*Acts 20:7 “Now on the first day of the week, when the disciples came together to break bread,”*



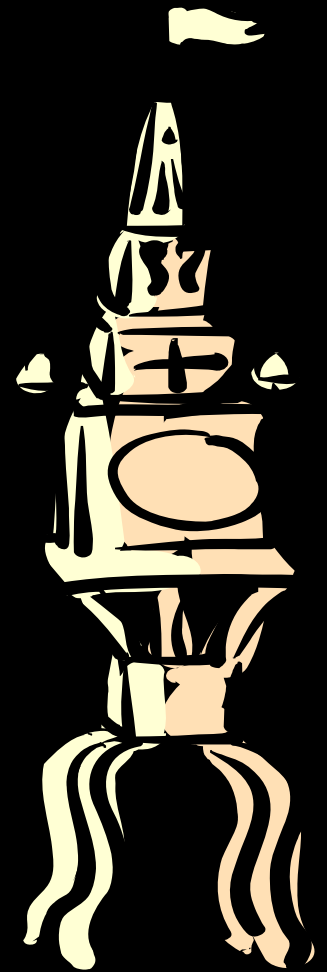
## Blessing over the **Wine**

*The first of the four Havdalah blessings is made over wine or grape juice.*



## Spices

*The second blessing is recited over fragrant spices. The spices represent the spices used for the altar of incense and also used to prepare the body for burial. The spices commonly used are cloves, cinnamon or bay leaves. They are commonly kept in a special decorated holder called a b'samim box. This is God's version of aromatherapy.*



## Fire

*The third blessing is recited over the special, multi-wicked Havdalah candle.*

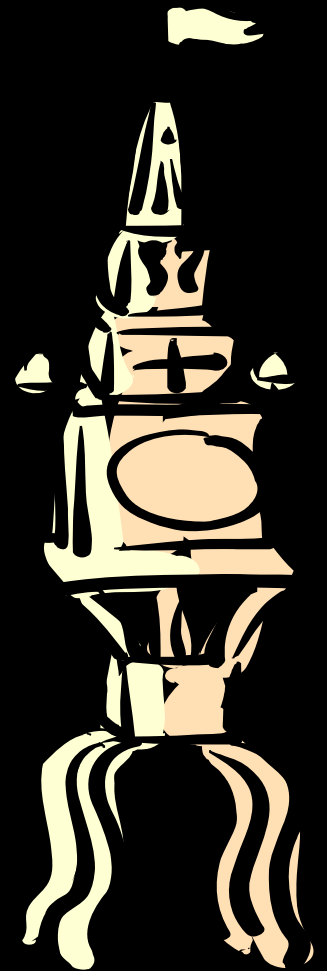

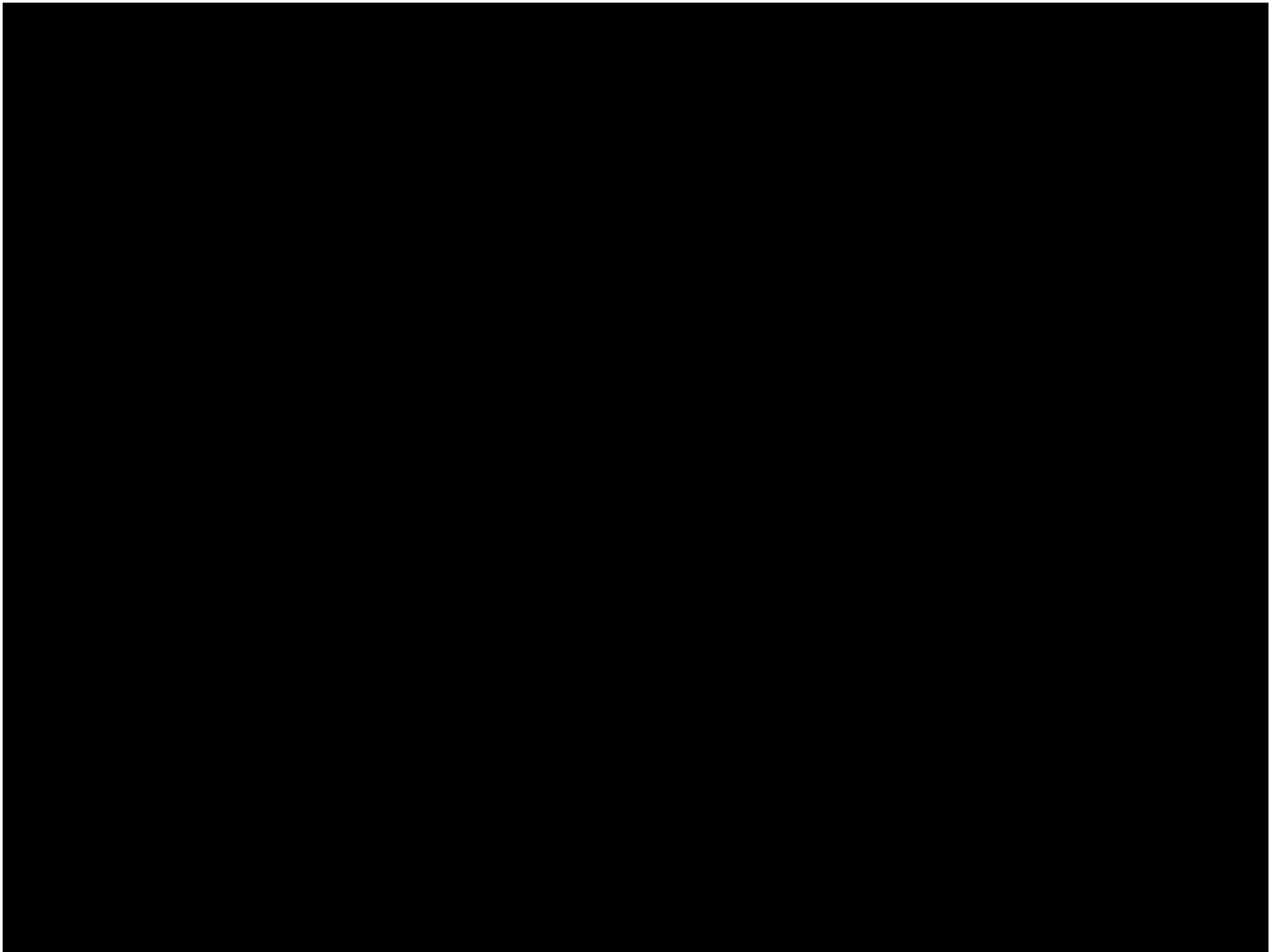
