*"I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing."
(John 15:5)*

Some trust in chariots and some in horses, but we trust in the name of the LORD our God. (Psalms 20:7)

Whoever has my commands and obeys them, he is the one who loves me. He who loves me will be loved by my Father, and I too will love him and show myself to him."

(John 14:21)

He who belongs to God hears what God says. The reason you do not hear is that you do not belong to God. " (John 8:47)

*Yeshua gave them this answer:
"I tell you the truth, the Son can do
nothing by himself; he can do only
what he sees his Father doing,
because whatever the Father does
the Son also does. (John 5:19)*

(John 14:23)*
